Once again Quilts of Valour - Canada ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ will be attending Quilt Canada! As promised a new block for you to: make a block, make a quilt and make a DIFFERENCE.


Brave and Bold - 12 12" unfinished Block

Fabric \& Colour cuts:
Yellow: $1-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}(\# 1)$
Red: $4-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}(\# 2)$
$4-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}(\# 3)$
2-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ X $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}(\# 4)$
White: 3-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2 \prime$ (\#5)
4-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}(\# 6)$
2-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}(\# 7)$
Assemble blocks with a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.

Quilts of Valour - Canada ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ is asking quilters across the country to make quilts for our injured serving military and our injured veterans from the Bento Box quilt block.

Make 2 squares:

Make one square each:


Sewing 5 rows of 6 blocks ( 30 blocks) will make a quilt approximately $60^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{\prime \prime}$.

- We encourage you to make the blocks from Northcott Fabric, not only using the Oh Canada line but any of the beautiful lines from Northcott.
- You may delve into your fabric stash (we know you have one) for red, whites/creams to build a Brave and Bold quilt for our injured military and injured veterans.
- At your discretion, you can use the yellow block, or not. Both versions will look wonderful.
- No borders are needed, just layer, quilt and bind!
- We ask that you also supply the binding for the Brave and Bold top that you donate. If you have any questions, please contact either:
